Performance Poetry

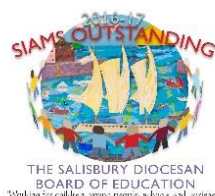

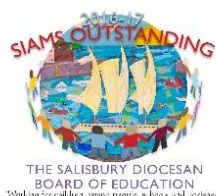

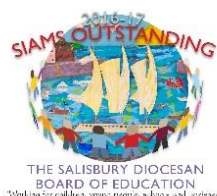
