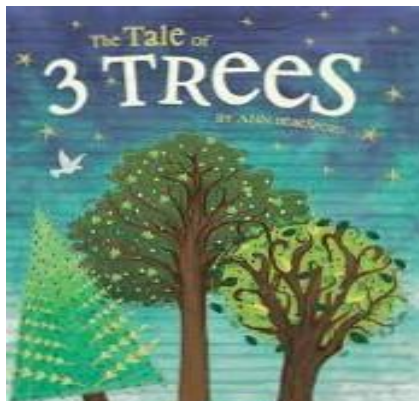


**We wish everyone a very Happy Easter. Summer term begins on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April.**
