Topic— Groovy Greeks

History— in History we will be taking a trip back in time to look at the Ancient Greeks. We will discover the people, the inventions, the art, the technology and the mythology of this fascinating civilisation. We will also discover how much of this civilisation is still alive in our society today in terms of language, architecture, the Olympic Games and more.

DT — in Design Technology we will exploring pneumatic systems and using air to create our own moving monster.

Art — in Art the children will be improving their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials such as pencil, charcoal, paint, and clay.

RE — in R.E. we will be looking at how people worship and different places of worship in different religions. We will also look at the qualities founders and leaders of religion demonstrate.

Computing — in Programming we will be using j2.com to create shapes by building algorithms. In Handling data we will be making simple databases. In Technology in our lives we will be searching websites for information on nutrition and healthy foods. We will use a search engine to find images.

Science — in Science we will compare and group different kinds of rocks depending upon their physical properties, describe how fossils are formed and recognise that soil is formed from rocks and organic matter.

Music — in Music we will be exploring rhythm and blues songs and experimenting with appropriate instruments.
