Starter

You are allowed to use the numbers 1,2,3 and 4—no others! You can use add, subtract, multiply or divide, you can also use square and cubes —the choice is yours. You can use all of the operations or only one, again it is up to you. Can you get to the number 100. What is the shortest way of getting there? How many ways can you find?

In Science we have been looking at classifying animals—mammals, reptiles, amphibians. Choose a BRITISH animal of your choice (not a pet, a wild animal) and write a report on it. In your report think about the sub-headings you could use—habitat, description, diet, life cycle.

Think about showing some of your information in different and interesting ways—diagrams etc.

REMEMBER— It has to be a British animal—so no lions!

Design or make a pair of slippers. Are they ones that you would like to wear—are they colourful, fluffy, do they look like Spiderman or rabbits? Or are they for your teacher. Think about what you know about them—what do they like? What colour could they be? Label your design—tell me what each material is and why you used it.



Desserts

Choice 1— Percentage Park

Have a look at this game—it helps you practise your fractions, percentages and decimals. Can you design your own park—10 squares by 10 squares and show the percentage/fraction of each section. Just like the game.

Choice 2— Make a fraction domino game that matches the written fraction to an image showing that fraction. Start with $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{1}{10}$, $\frac{1}{6}$ and $\frac{1}{8}$. If confident try fractions such as $\frac{2}{3}$, $\frac{4}{5}$, $\frac{8}{10}$.

Drinks

Design a poster that shows KS1 children how to be a good friend. Think about the qualities you need, what you should do and who they could ask for help if things go wrong. Remember it is for KS1 so think about the vocabulary that you use.
