## Heads over Tails

# Starter

Put 4 coins on a table in a row—all tails up like this :



Turn ANY 3 coins over—this counts as one move. YOU MUST TURN 3 DIFFERENT COINS TO COMPLETE ONE MOVE!

How many moves will it take to get all of the coins on heads? Remember you have to turn 3 coins in each move! How could you show this as part of your project—could you draw your investigation?

# Main Course

## Meat Option

Select an inspirational sporting personality and research information about them. Use your findings to write a biographical recount about them. Choose someone who interests and inspires you.



In your writing make sure you tell me why they are so inspiring. If you wish you can include paintings, drawings, photographs of your personality.



## Vegetarian Option

This is a still life painting by Cezanne. Paint a still life of your own. Think



about what you want to draw or paint—arrange them somewhere and remember to draw what you see.

Be careful that you look at the size of your objects—get the correct perspective. You can make your drawing or painting whatever size you want.



# Desserts

**Choice 1**— Compose a poem about your time at Rainham Village Primary School. Think about the things that have happened to you over the years—the trips you have been on, experiences you have had. Write it out neatly and decorate it.

Remember poems do not need to rhyme.

**Choice 2**— Create a 3D model using materials of your choice. This might be of an animal, plant, human or anything of your choice, including anything POTTER based.



# Drinks
