



On Tuesday 25th June 2019 Year 6 will be visiting Southport. Children will need to be dropped off and collected from Appley Bridge Train Station.

The next Year 6 topic is, 'Oh I Do Like to Be Beside the Seaside'. During this topic, the children will study the human and physical geography of Southport comparing it with other places studied previously. They will consider elements such as tourism, transport, settlements, land use and change over time through the use of maps, images and other sources of geographical information.



A voluntary contribution of £5.00 per child is required for this visit to cover the cost of the train. Payments and consent can now be completed on School Money. The children will require a packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag (no glass please) and they will need to wear school uniform. £5 spending money is suggested.
