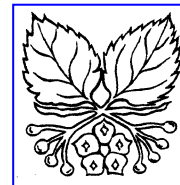

Dear Families & Friends

Class Photos and Whole School Photo

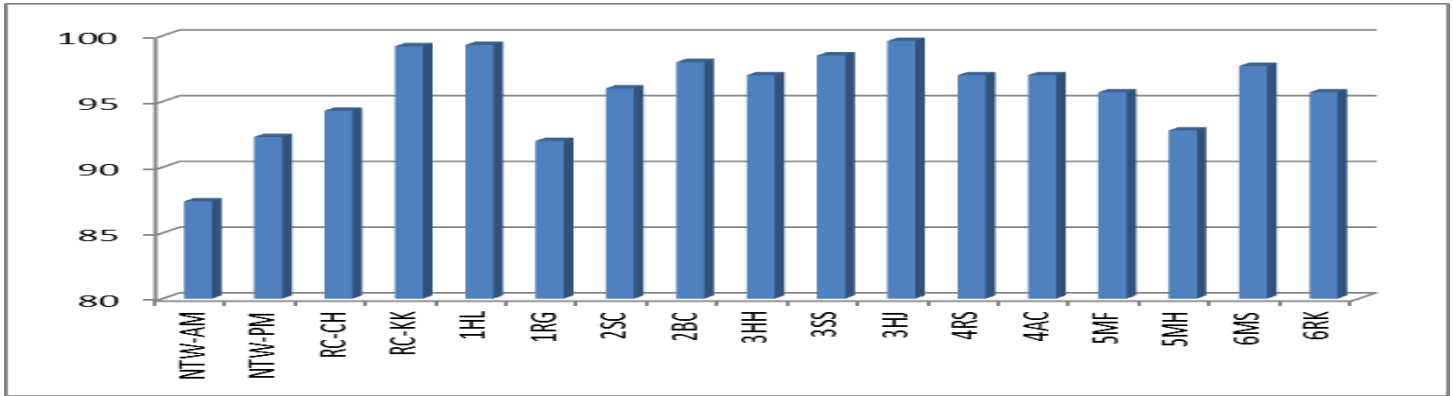
