**Swimming**

Swimming will start immediately after the May half term and the children will need to have a named swimming costume and towel in school daily in a bag suitable for hanging on their pegs. This year we have had to slightly raise the pool contributions from parents (which have remained unchanged for the last 3 years), to £33 per child (£50 in total if you have two or more children at the school). As the children will swim 3 times per week (weather dependent), this works out at approximately £1.37 per swim. Kindly return the slip below with your donation between now and half term. Please make cheques payable to 'Friends of Chilworth Infant School' or you can pay cash or on-line.

Here at Chilworth School we teach our children to enjoy and find confidence in water. We develop awareness of safety, health and life skills. Skills range from moving in water to floating with and without aids, gliding, diving under water to specific strokes. Your child will come home with a certificate when they have achieved certain milestones.

For health and safety reasons we need to have three adults to help supervise around the pool for the in-school swimming sessions. If you have any spare time and could possibly help please speak to your child's teacher. There will be a rota available before half term. You also need to be DBS checked, so if you are interested but not DBS checked, please see Kim now to get the necessary forms; the processing of this can take some time.

If you have any spare swimming costumes (girls and boys) that you no longer require we would be most grateful to have them in school.
