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**This week:**

In English, Endeavour and Beagle have planned and written narrative stories based on a Viking tale. Discovery have looked at the key features of diaries as part of their non-fiction work.

In Maths, Discovery and Endeavour have been converting decimals to percentages and fractions, and Beagle, have revised money and time.

RE focused on the Ascension of Jesus and all of the emotions that the disciples would have felt. In DT we are continuing with our moving toys projects exploring the use of cams and levers and in Science the children are completing their models of the Solar System.
