Dear Parents,

After our recent Health and Safety audit, I would like to remind our parents of the following safety rules so that we can keep all of our children and adults safe at all times:

1. ALWAYS drive at 5 mph in/out of the car park and near to the main school gate and school entrance
2. ALWAYS give right of way to cars coming out of the car park
3. REVERSE into parking spots
4. DO NOT park in our car park in a way that is obstructing the path leading to the school field as children and adults are using this
5. DO NOT park in the accessibility space to the left of the main entrance as this is reserved for people with disabilities only
6. ONLY Children/families who have parked in our car park are to use the path leading from the school car park onto the field
7. Children who have not used the car park MUST use the main school gate to enter school
8. We have a space in front of our Reception/office area that is used by our school taxi every day. Please DO NOT use this to drop off/pick up your children

I know we can support each other to keep everyone safe at St Mary's and I will keep you informed of signage/markings that will be implemented when I have heard back from the council.
