Mental Health and Well-being Adverse Childhood Experiences



There are 10 known main contributors which affect young people even from babies onwards. These are known as adverse childhood experiences otherwise known as ACE.

Where a child may experience or observe even 3 or 4 of the following within the home, it can result in severe emotional and behavioural difficulties and even mental health problems in teenage years and early adulthood.

If your child has experienced any of these and show signs of behavioural difficulties, they may require intensive support. Usually, a secure adult influence where there is consistent nurture, care and comfort, adverse emotional reactions may not emerge or may be reduced.

MIND at positive steps can offer support.

Let us know in school if you wish to discuss anything which you feel may have affected your child so that we can also offer support where possible.

Act now and reduce further trauma in later years.

ACEs: The 10 Areas of Trauma

1. Psychological Abuse
2. Physical Abuse
3. Sexual Abuse
4. Emotional Neglect
5. Physical Neglect
6. Loss of a Parent (for any reason)
7. Mother Treated Violently
8. Substance Abuse
9. Mental Illness
10. Criminal Behavior in the Household
