### Looking forward

### Maths

This term we will be focusing on how to keep ourselves safe around water, fire, the road and the railway. We will also be looking growth and the lifecycle. This will include aspects of growing up and thinking about themes related to this.

### English



In Communication, Language and Literacy the children will be focusing on listening to a range of different books including both fiction and non-fiction texts. The children will also continue to use their daily phonic lessons to support them in their reading and writing activities. In their writing the children will be focusing on learning to hold a sentence, build a sentence and to write well structured sentences..

### R.E



The unit that we will be looking at this half term will be Bible Stories and we will particularly focus on the story 'The Lost Sheep'. After half term we will look at the Bible story 'Jonah and the Whale'.
