



PE and Sport Premium 2015-2016

The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help primary schools to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities that they offer to pupils. Each school receives £8000 plus an additional payment of £5 per pupil in Years 1 to 6. For us, this amounts to £8900.

The funding at St Kentigern's is used:

- To employ a specialist PE teacher and coaches to work alongside teachers in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence in PE.
- To buy into the Blackpool Football Club Community Trust 'Fit2Go' programme for year 4, working with teachers, pupils and families.
- To employ a local coach to provide after school sports clubs - basketball, hockey and football for boys and girls.
- To employ a local coach to increase pupils' participation in local and national school games competitions, e.g. Youth Games, Football Festivals, Boccia tournament, etc.
- To employ a PE coach who provides sporting activities on the MUPA every lunchtime, one weekday per class for Years 2-6.
- To engage pupils in after school activities, e.g. Change4Life after school club.
- To employ specialist teachers to develop a non-traditional activity, e.g. Teaching Judo in Year 3.
