

## English



**Fiction Units** – Fantasy & play scripts

**Non- Fiction Units** – letters, Diaries, non-chronological texts and explanations

**Poetry** – language choice for purpose.

**Grammar**-this will continue to be taught daily throughout English lessons. The children will be developing their knowledge of word types, and accurate use of punctuation marks.

**Spellings**-we will continue to practise spellings daily. Spelling lists will be sent home each week and tested every Friday. Please practise these with your child as often as possible.

**Reading** – will be taught through the text based units above, guided reading sessions and through encouragement of continued, sustained independent reading of the pupils. PLEASE HELP

**Reading**- Guided reading sessions are completed daily in class. Children are expected to read 5 times per week for 5 minutes on books of their choosing or with their school reading books. They must complete their reading diary daily.

**RE-** We will study 3 topics- Transformation, Freedom & Responsibility, and Stewardship.

**Transformation**– the children learn about transforming energy, and Pentecost.

**Freedom & Responsibility** – the children learn about their freedoms & God's rules.

**Stewardship** – Doing God's work, Helping the world and others.

## Mathematics

**Number** – read, write and order numbers up to 7 digits including with decimals and negative numbers

**Calculation skills** – addition, subtraction and multiplication and division

**2D and 3D shapes** – properties of shapes and position and direction.

**Fractions** – equivalence, compare, order and of quantities then calculating with fractions.

**Angles and Statistics**- including algebra

**Measurement** - perimeter and area.

**Problem solving and reasoning activities** will be embedded into each area of learning. The children will continue to practise their recall of multiplication and division facts and mixed tests will be every Friday. Please continue to practise these with your child.
