Week Beginning 1st April

For the final week of term, we will be looking at how we, and people all around the world celebrate Easter. We will be writing recipes for Easter nest cakes and then making them, going on an Easter egg hunt, decorating and rolling hard-boiled eggs and making our own Easter bonnets to help tell stories with. **Please remember to bring a hard-boiled egg in on either Monday or Tuesday.** There will be no outdoor learning this week, however we will be spending lots of time outside to go on several different hunts, including a chocolate egg hunt!

In Maths we will be problem solving, using addition, subtraction, halving and doubling.

If you would like to support your child further at home, you could:

- Decorate an egg using repeating patterns.
- Try a traditional Easter food, such as hot cross buns or simnel cake.
- Create your own Easter egg hunt, writing clues so your friends and family to know where to look!
- Make up your own problem solving question using either subtraction or addition, for example; There were 5 hot cross buns and 2 were eaten. How many are left?
- Try making a model basket to hold some Easter treats, you could use a cereal box or an egg box.
