The Curriculum

During your child's time in Nursery and Reception they will be following the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. This curriculum sets the standards for Learning, Development and care for children from birth to five years.

The curriculum is organised into seven areas of learning.

1. Personal, Social and Emotional Development
2. Communication and Language
3. Physical Development
4. Literacy Development
5. Mathematical Development
6. Understanding of the World
7. Expressive Arts and Design

All these areas will be taught through well planned and structured play activities. It is through play that children develop intellectually, creatively, physically, socially and emotionally.

How can I help my child
