VB-MAPP Curriculum	<p>The VB-MAPP curriculum is used as a tool to progress our children’s learning so that they may work towards accessing the National Curriculum. It has a number of strands across three levels of development which together typically equate to 0-48 months of age. These strands include Mand (making requests), Tact (labelling things), Listener Response (reacting to others’ requests), Visual Perception Skills and Matching to Sample, Independent Play, Social Behaviour and Social Play, Motor Imitation, Echoic Skills, Vocal Skills, Listener Responding by Feature, Function and Class, Intra Verbal Skills, Classroom Routines and Group Skills, Linguistics, Writing, Reading and Maths.</p>
