

What will I learn?

A BTEC is a practical, work related course. You learn by completing projects and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands. It introduces you to the employment area you have chosen and provides a good basis to go on to a more advanced work-related qualification. In Business Studies, you will cover nine units each looking at a different aspect of business, from setting up your own business to how businesses operate online.

Highlights

You could take this course to prepare for studying A Levels. You could go straight into a job related to business as the BTEC is a recognised qualification that will help you develop basic knowledge and understanding of how a business works. Successful completion of the course leads to an equivalent of three GCSEs at level 4 or above.
