Highlights

Students consistently get grades far higher than their forecast grades. There is currently a 100% pass rate at A Level and the AS Sociology results have been in the top 25% of schools nationally over the past 4 years. Many students went on to study Sociology, or related subjects, at University including those achieving places at Nottingham and Southampton.
