Year 6 are invited to enter the Minety MasterChef competition, held at Minety on Friday 14th June 2019. Working in pairs, teams are asked to produce **one dish that uses at least two products from the list below**. The theme is “**Love food, hate waste**”. Dishes will be judged on taste, presentation and theme.

1. POTATOES

Daily waste in British households: 5.8 million whole potatoes

2. BREAD

Daily waste in British households: 24 million slices of bread

3. MILK

Daily waste in British households: 5.8 million glasses of milk

4. BANANAS

Daily waste in British households: 1.4 million edible bananas

5. SALAD

Annual waste in British households: 178 million bags of salad

6. EGGS

Daily waste in British households: 1.1 million eggs.

7. VEGETABLES

A few points of clarification:

- Students will be cooking one dish between two, with half an hour prep and one hour cooking time
- All utensils and equipment needed for the dish must be supplied by the pupils. E.g. knives, plates, pots, decorations. Pupils can use their own small gas burners and will be supervised in class with these. We will provide tables and ovens at school.
- The winning team will represent Minety at the Malmesbury masterChef event on Tuesday 18th June 2019
