

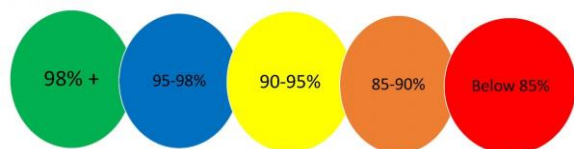


What is good attendance?
