KS2 Sports Day

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Parish Council have kindly offered us the use of the **Bransgore Cricket Ground** as our venue for the KS2 Sports Day. This is a fantastic opportunity to bring our school to the centre of the community and for the children to have a good size track to run around.

Arrangements on the day:

What the children need to wear and bring with them

We would like the children to come into school on Thursday 13th June wearing their PE kit. They will need: a coloured t-shirt to represent their house team, their normal PE shorts, trainers, sun hat, sun cream and drinks bottle.

Refreshments

We will provide areas of shade for the children and ensure they have extra water available. Parents and spectators will be able to purchase refreshments kindly provided by the BSA. We would ask that parents bring a picnic rug or their own camping chairs if they wish, as we will only have a few chairs available at the venue.

Timings

We aim to start at **12.45pm** and have it all wrapped up by **2.30pm** (which allows plenty of time to get back to school to collect siblings).

Parking and end of day arrangements

There will be parking available at the cricket ground and across the road at the recreation ground but I would suggest that walking would be the best option. To ensure your children stay safe, please could you fill in the reply slip to state who will be collecting them from the cricket ground if not being collected by parent and return this to school by **Tuesday 11th June**.

Changes for this year's Sports Day!

Theme of the event: 'Encourage'

This year's sports day will have the theme of 'Encourage'. This word has been chosen as the central theme for the event based on our loving school ethos. This is to 'encourage' a positive attitude from all towards sporting events and to 'encourage' children to try their best and to cheer on each other. The winning house group will be based on the team that best encompasses the theme 'encourage' by displaying positive sportsmanship traits; this may not necessarily be the team that is the first place in the track events, although these scores will still be announced.



Maximum participation

This year, the track and field events will be happening at the same time. This is in order to maximise participation and to reduce hanging around. All Year 3 and 4 will start by competing in a carousel of 8 non-competitive field events, while the Year 5 and 6 will start by competing in 3 competitive track events: 400m sprint, 50m sprint and relay. The children interested in the track events have completed in heats during their Outdoor Games sessions to decide the final runners. We will make it clear on the day with announcements which events are taking place at what time to ensure that you can get to the right spot to watch your child participating.

Adult participation

Please come wearing your trainers as we will be inviting you to join in with us for the Zumba warm up and Yoga cooldown. We would 'encourage' you to be prepared to join in as your participation may well contribute to the winning team of our theme 'Encourage'!

Photos

If you would like to take photos of your children please note you have already signed the **GENERAL CONSENT FORM** at the beginning of the year stating that - *(I agree that I will not make any additional or multiple copies of photos or video footage containing children other than my own for personal use or to share with others. I will not email any photos/video footage containing children other than my own. I will not upload any photos/video footage containing children other than my own to ANY social media site/ website, protected or otherwise).*

The only other thing left to organise is the weather! We hope for a dry day but if it is raining (or extreme heat), we will postpone the event and reschedule for the following Thursday 20th June.
