Each child needs to prepare a presentation on a world event or achievement; some examples from previous years are: Plastic Pollution, The Calgary Stampede, Hiroshima, The Bumble Bee Crisis, The Yucatan Meteorite, Super Volcanoes and the Everest Avalanche.

They should be prepared to talk to the class for about 4/5 minutes and can include pictures, diagrams or illustrations; they may do it as a PowerPoint presentation if they wish but they do not have to; a confident presentation with good knowledge and eye contact is what we are looking for. They need to describe the event clearly, where it occurred and any impact it has had.

If they have used a PowerPoint presentation, they can bring their presentation in on a memory stick or email it to the school office.

We will begin with the children in Year 6 and will go in alphabetical order down the register and hope to see about 10 presentations each week; Years 4 and 5 will therefore have more time to prepare.
