Look out for the weekly Home Tasks to do with your child over the weekend.

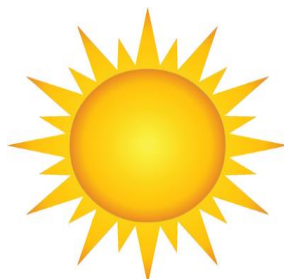
#### Theme - Summer Term
