



Driffield Junior School



Dear Parents/Carers

During the summer term, year 4 will be learning about animal classification, habitats, conservation and the human impact on animal populations. This will also lead in to our learning about food chains and digestion.

To support this learning, we are planning a trip to **Yorkshire Wildlife Park (YWP) in Doncaster**. As well as visiting YWP and seeing nearly 400 animals and 70 different species from the environments that we are learning about for real, each class will also be taking part in a workshop to learn more about the African habitats that will be driving much of our class learning. These workshops will allow us to meet and get hands on with some of YWP's more unusual animals.

This is a fantastic opportunity to bring the learning we do in classrooms to life.

The visit will take place on **Tuesday 2nd July** with all 4 classes going on the same day.

Timing Children need to be in their classroom **by 8.45am** on trip day, so that the bus can leave promptly at 9.00am. We expect to be back in Driffield for **4:30pm**.

Clothing Children should come in normal school uniform, with a sensible choice of shoes, as there will be a lot of walking involved with this trip. As YWP has very limited indoor areas, a lightweight coat is also required. A backpack to carry lunch is also essential as there is nowhere to store baggage.

Lunch A packed lunch is required (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). If your child is currently receiving free school meals, they are entitled to a free packed lunch for trips. If you would like a packed lunch providing for your child, please indicate this on the form.

Payment There is a voluntary contribution towards the cost of this visit of **£17.90** per child. This includes entrance to YWP (£7.50 per child), workshops in YWP's educational facility (£1.60 per child) and coach travel (£8.80 per child). If your child is currently receiving free school meals, the cost of this trip will be paid for from Pupil Premium so please indicate this on the form. In order to ascertain whether the trip is financially viable we are asking that consent forms and payments be sent in to school by **Friday 28th June**.

We are also very grateful to the schools PSA who are paying to treat the children to an ice cream. Please indicate on the slip if you do not wish your child to have one.

This is a new trip for Driffield Junior School, but we are very confident that the excellent practical activities will help create a powerful, enriching and enjoyable learning experience.
