Calling all Year 5 parents

The secondary admissions processes for September 2020 are about to begin.

The first stages of the process are information presentations and the registration for the Medway Test for entry to Medway grammar schools. There are a few key dates to remember:

Medway Council Parent Presentations – Each venue has 2 sessions, at 4:30pm and 6:30pm

- Tuesday 4 June – The Hundred of Hoo Academy
- Wednesday 5 June – Chatham Grammar School for Girls
- Thursday 6 June – Sir Joseph Williamson's Mathematical School

There is no need for parents to register their interest, just turn up on the day.

Children are welcome to attend with their parents if childcare cannot be arranged.

Registering for the Medway Test:

- Registration opens – Monday 3 June, 9am
- Registration closes – Monday 1 July, 5pm

If a paper registration is required, a form can be collected from Medway Council Offices at Gun Wharf, dock Road, Chatham, ME4 4TR

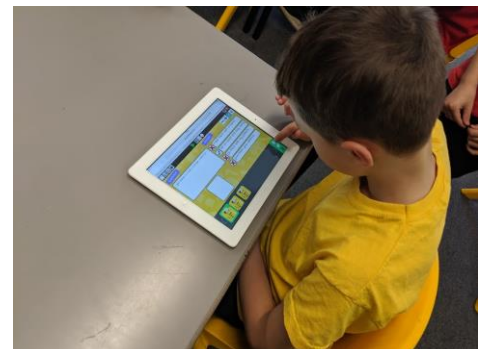
Special Arrangements for the Medway Test:

requests can only be submitted by the child's school. School Admissions and Transport cannot accept requests direct from parents. Any request must be received from the school by School Admissions and Transport by **Monday 8 July**.
