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Dear Parent and carers,

We are writing to advise you that we will be delivering a unit of work on Sex and Relationships Education after half-term. Our Sex and Relationships Education Programme is closely linked with our PSHE Programme (personal, social, health and economic education). It is based around seven topics - keeping safe, feelings, relationships, gender stereotypes, online technology safety, my body and lifecycles. The 'My Body' topic will include talking about puberty and the physical and emotional changes that take place; this will be revisited from our Year 5 programme and is a requirement of the KS2 National Science Curriculum. We will then deliver lessons from our 'Life Cycles' topic which includes how babies are made and born and multiple births. The 'Gender Stereotypes' topic covers a lesson on sexual orientation; this is through the perspective of developing respect for others.

The teaching will be delivered using a range of methods including video clips, discussions and group activities.
