

## Explanation of Report to Parents Autumn 2018-19 – Example Report

**Attendance** (99% outstanding, 96%+ good. Pupils should be on at least our school target of 96%).

**Punctuality** (This is a record of the number of times pupils have been marked in as late. We expect this figure to be lower than 6 over the academic year).

**Achievement Points** (This figure shows the number of times pupils have gone above and beyond expectations and teachers have rewarded their efforts. It covers both curricular and extra-curricular efforts).

**Behaviour Points** (these are given to pupils when their behaviour falls below our high expectations. We would want these points to be as close to 0 as possible over the course of the academic year).

Academic progress data criteria is summarised as follows:

**Y10-Y11 ONLY Minimum Target grade (MTG)** (These are based on KS2 fine scores/CATs tests. Achieving this grade ensures the pupil has made above average progress).

**Y10-Y11 ONLY Termly Assessment Grade (AG)** (this is the grade achieved in the most recent end of term assessment which is expressed as a 1-9 grade or Pass-Merit for BTEC courses).

**Termly Progress** (this summarises the progress made for the subject by comparing the MTG with the assessment grade. Progress below 0 zero requires improvement, 0.1-0.29 is good and 0.3+ is outstanding).

**Y10-Y11 ONLY Professional Predicted Grade (PPG)** (this is the grade that is fully informed by the assessment, classwork and homework and acts as a professional prediction of what the pupil will most likely attain at the end of Y11).

**Attitude to Learning** (this is a teacher assessment of the scholarly characteristics the pupil has displayed in both classwork and homework. It is graded on a 1-10 scale, with 1 being the lowest and 10 the highest).
