- **Car parking** - There is plenty of car parking available at £2.00 per car at the Laverstock & Ford Social Club. Very limited is available parking at the secondary schools and Enovation. **Do not** park in the One Stop, along Church Road or in Elm Close. Be aware that cars parked are parked entirely at the owner's risk.
- Enter the site **via St Andrew's Primary School, not the secondary schools.**
- Please arrive in good time and look out for the blue Sarum St Paul's tent. Mrs Field, Miss Martindale, Mrs Shinn and Miss Mitchell are all attending.
- The course is uneven & rutted – sturdy trainers must be worn, take extreme care.
- Do not cross the track to accompany your children to the start of the race.
- Do not enter St Edmund's, Wyvern or St Joseph's School buildings at any time.
- Toilet facilities are available without entering the main buildings, portaloos are on the field.
