Sixth Form Contract

I understand that I have made a positive choice in deciding to continue my studies at St Gregory the Great Sixth Form.

Accordingly, I agree to meet the following expectations:

- To work to the best of my ability both in class and independently, ensuring that all work is completed to the best standard and completed on time.
- To make a positive contribution to the Sixth Form and wider school community, including participation in mentoring younger students.
- To respect faiths, beliefs and other protected characteristics of all students and staff
- To ensure responsible use of social media sites, ensuring that messages and posts are not inappropriate or offensive to others.
- To respect the school environment, particularly the Sixth Form common room, computer rooms and library.
- To be responsible for and to wear my ID badge on site at all times in accordance with the school's safeguarding policy.
- To attend school every day between 8.40 am and 3.10 pm and to attend and be punctual to *all* lessons, tutor times and assemblies. **Students will only be permitted to leave site during break and lunchtime and must ensure they return to lessons punctually. Attendance below 90% will trigger withdrawal from exams and loss of place to study in sixth form.**
- To behave responsibly around the school and the immediate surroundings, be considerate of other users of the site and set a good example to younger students.
- To only use mobile phones and music devices in the Sixth Form area and to keep these away when walking around site and in lessons unless given permission by a teacher.
- To ensure that all work handed in for marking is my own original work except where other sources have been explicitly acknowledged.
- To provide notes promptly for *unavoidable* absences to the Deputy Head of Sixth Form and to be responsible for catching up work missed during such absences.
- To ensure that holidays are not taken during school term and, where possible, other appointments and events happen outside of lesson time.
- To respect the Catholic ethos and mission statement of the school, attending masses and reflections as directed.
- To attend detentions after school as requested
- Not to bring the school into disrepute

St Gregory the Great Sixth Form has clear standards for its students and will celebrate and reward those who are excellent examples of fulfilling these expectations. Appropriate sanctions will be applied to students who fail to meet the above expectations; including detentions for attendance, behaviour and punctuality.
