Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Another short week!

Following on from Jasper's Beanstalk we have read 'Jack and the Beanstalk' this week. The story language and sequence was reinforced with a story map and through role play. All children have written a sentence about the Giant and some children went on to re-tell the story in their writing. They were encouraged to use the time language learnt last week as well as to use the story language that we have talked about.

In maths the children have been consolidating work on time, telling and recording the o'clock times. We have also moved on to measures using CM. The children have measured beanstalks using cm. We have talked about how we know which is the longest and shortest measurement and how to measure accurately.

In the creative area the children looked at seed heads and made observational drawings. We are trying to encourage the children to draw what they can see as opposed to what they think they can see or what they would like to see!

## Things to note:

- Education City reminder. We are pleased that some children have been able to access this at home. Please note that this supports the Understanding the World Goal for technology and accessing these programs will reinforce work done at school. More content has been added to this so please do continue to take a look with your child.
- Some of the children have been asking about 'Times Tables Rock stars Challenge' as older siblings are completing the challenges. As such we have added children's names if you are interested. The idea is that they complete the times tables in a fast time. We recommend if you decide to do this that children only complete 2 and 5 X tables initially. If you would like your child's log in details please let us know.
