Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Our focus this week has been 'The Little Red Riding Hood'. During 'Choosing Time' the children have had the opportunity to create wolf masks using plates and to make red buns to go in Grandma's basket. We have also been learning about materials and have sorted a number of items into the material they are made out of (plastic, wood, glass or metal). For the 'job of the week' the children did the sorting independently.

During phonics the children wrote a letter to the wolf or have labelled and described the wolf.

In maths we have continued to add single digits by counting on from the largest number as well as to find one more and one less, recording answers and then checking that we have the correct number formation. Some children are still unsure of the language 'more' and 'less'.

Things to note:

- There are some children who do not have sun cream at school. We are therefore assuming that all of these children have all day protection on already (applied at home) and do not require topping up of sun cream. As stated in the previous letter, children do spend a lot of time outside.
- Please do send in sun hats and water bottles too. Thank you.
- We notice that a lot of the children are coming to school with party tattoos. We politely request that these are removed for school.
