We would like to remind you that we operate a healthy eating policy in our school and would be grateful if you could choose healthy options for your child's lunch box.

Attendance

Reminder: The law states that headteacher's are no longer able to authorise absences for the purpose of holidays.. For those families who still take their children out of school, the school will instigate proceedings that may result in these families being fined. The current level of fine is £60 per parent per child per week; so, if you take two children out of school the fine would be £240 per week!

So far this year 42 children have taken extended leave resulting in 517 days being lost. This is totally unacceptable.

Internet Safety

We must remind you that it is the responsibility of all parents to ensure that their child is safe when using the internet. The Government has strict guidelines regarding access in place but parents must ensure that these guidelines are adhered to. Reminder of our Uniform Policy
