Geography

- Study the continent of North America
 - Use and praise different sources of geographical information
- Make comparisons within North America and with the United Kingdom by studying physical features such as the Great Lakes, the San Andreas Fault, mountain ranges, rivers and violent weather.
- Compare and contrast human features such as famous landmarks, land use and culture.
 - Create maps of locations identifying patterns (such as: land use, climate zones, population densities, height of land).
