Dear Parents/Carers,

Red Class will start their next block of Forest School sessions after the half term. The sessions will take place in the mornings on the following dates:

This is an exciting learning opportunity where the children get to experience learning in an outdoor environment in different seasons whether it is rain or shine. In order to make it a fully enjoyable experience, the children need to wear appropriate clothing so that they remain warm and dry. All clothing should be old as it will get muddy.

Waterproof trousers/waterproof all-in-one suits are fantastic for Forest School (especially for rainy days) however, if you do not have these the school can provide waterproof trousers for the children if required. There are also wellington boots if needed.

All clothing needs to be brought into school in a named bag and placed on their peg. If you could provide a plastic bag for their muddy boots as well, it would be greatly appreciated! The children will get changed for Forest School in the classroom so it is important that all clothing is labelled so that no one loses anything.
