Well done to the children who won their races: Martha (Y6), Riley (Y5), Lexi (Y4) and Evie (Y3).

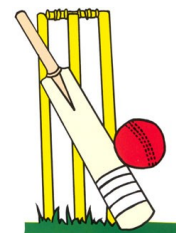


Football
