Week commencing 3.6.19 Art	How many famous artists can you name?	Choose a famous piece of art work. Write some facts about the art work and artist.	Choose a famous piece of artwork. Explain what you like or don't like about it.	Design your own page that could go inside our book 'Beautiful Oops'.
Week commencing 10.6.19 Literacy/Philosophy	Explain what you think the book Beautiful Oops is about.	Can it be good to make mistakes? Explain your answer.	Write about a time when you have made a mistake. How did you fix it?	Create a cartoon strip to show when you have made a mistake and how you fixed it.
Week commencing 17.6.19 PE	Name some famous sportsmen or women. What sports do they compete in?	Think of an athletics activity and explain how to do it. Are there any rules that need to be followed?	Choose an athletics activity (Running, bouncing a ball, egg and spoon) Time how long you can do the activity for. Can you beat your score?	Create a cheer for your sports day team. Can you perform it?
Week commencing 24.6.19 Character muscles	Write down a list of character muscles and what they mean.	Draw a picture of yourself and write down which character muscles you think you are good at.	Write about a time where you have used a character muscle in year 1.	Choose a character muscle e.g. perseverance, creativity, self-control etc... Make a poster about it.
Week commencing 1.7.19 Maths	Name as many different 2D shapes and 3D shapes as you can.	Choose some 3D shapes. Explain what 2D shapes you can see on its surface. E.g. A cube - 6 squares	Look around your house. How many 2D and 3D objects can you spot? Write them in a list. E.g. Tissue box - Cuboid Window - Rectangle	Make a 3D shape using a net. Can you label the 2D shapes on its surfaces?
Week commencing 8.7.19 PSHE	List 5 things your new teacher might need to know about you.	Write about your favourite part of Y1 and explain why.	Write a letter to your new teacher. Think about what you would like to tell them about yourself.	Write a poem about your time in Y1.
