Week 2 Geography	List some of the islands in Scotland.	Create a model of a famous Scottish place.	Construct a map of Scotland showing major places of industry and /or landmarks.	What evidence can you present for the existence/non-existence of the Loch Ness monster.	Create and record a TV advertisement for tourism in Scotland.	Compare and contrast the different tourist attractions in Scotland and England.
Week 3 Literacy	If you could meet a famous Scottish person who would it be and what questions would you ask?	List the qualities that an artist would need.	Create a colourful spider diagram of all you know about Charles Rennie Mackintosh.	Conduct a mock interview with Charles Rennie Mackintosh himself.	Create a comic strip about Charles' life.	Imagine you work for Mackintosh, draw and write about a creation of your own (artwork, building architecture, furniture, jewellery). Explain why you believe in this design.
Week 4 Maths	Plot the annual rainfall in Scotland on a bar chart.	Construct a time line which summarizes what happens in Charles' life using key dates and events.	Rank the cities in Scotland in terms of the population and place them on a line graph.	Create a graph to show the highest mountain in Scotland compared to the rest of the world.	Create a timeline showing the births of famous Scottish people.	Find a Scottish recipe including measurements. Make the dish then evaluate how successful it was (what you liked and didn't like about it).
Week 5 Art	Write your full name Art Nouveau style.	Find and draw some of your favourite examples of Art Nouveau glasswork.	Draw/label a traditional Scottish costume. Explain when it's worn.	Analyse examples of Art Nouveau architecture e.g. patterns/shape/theme.	Create some fashion items in the style of art nouveau and label the features.	Create a monster (like the Loch Ness monster). Explain what it is associated with.
Week 6 History	Name when and where Charles Mackintosh was born.	Look at the history of some of Mackintosh's jewellery. Create your own piece and write about the design of it.	Write a newspaper article about the history of Mackintosh.	Conduct a mock interview with Charles, ask him to design our new classroom. (What would he put in etc).	Create a tourist pamphlet detailing information about the building's Charles designed.	Evaluate a Mackintosh design of your choosing and justify your likes, dislikes and changes you would make.
