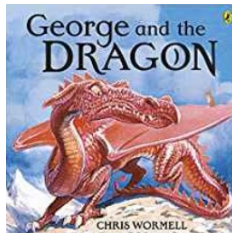


ENGLISH

In English the children will be writing an adventure story based on the book *George and the Dragon*. The children will be looking at the story structure of defeating a monster and recreating their own heroes and villains.



Later in the term the children will be learning how to write effective instructions. Using a model text we will rewrite instructions on how to capture a mythical creature such as an ogre or a fairy.

The children will continue to get spellings sent home weekly and we strongly encourage you to support them in learning them.

As always, please ensure you hear your child read as much as possible.

ART & DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In art the children will be looking at animals from the 7 continents of the world and will represent these in unique and exciting ways. They will create aboriginal art, 3D models and totem poles.



In DT the children will design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria. They will be making an animal puppet to share with their peers.

PE

In indoor PE, the children will be participating in a multi skill festival.

In out door PE the children will be completing outdoor adventure activities, including trails. They will be working on team work activities as well.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography the children will name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.



They will look at animals that are native to that continent. They will learn how and why the animals are important to the country they live in.



Music In Music the children will be listening to a piece of classical music. They will be encouraged to play musical instruments along with the music as well as performing the piece to an audience.

Computing

In computing the children will be using Purple Mash (which the children are able to access at home) to explore the different ways that information can be presented. They will make a quiz, a fact file and carry out a presentation.



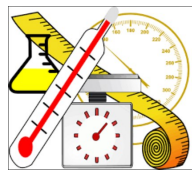
They will also be using the chrome books to take quizzes linked to stories that we have read.

MATHS



Year 2 will continue to look at measurement in maths. We will look at time. The children will be learning to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes. They will be using language like quarter past and quarter to. To support this learning try to encourage the children to tell the time at home.

The children will also be learning about measuring mass, capacity, length and temperature.



SCIENCE—Super scientists

In science the children will be looking at the work of some amazing scientists from the past and present to see how they have had an impact on our world. We will look at the work of Isaac Newton, Alexander Graham Bell, Florence Nightingale, Alexander Fleming, Louis Pasteur and Thomas Edison

RE IN RE the children will be answering the following question: ***What can we learn from sacred books and stories?***

PSHE In PSHE the children will be studying a unit called medicines and me. They will learn about what happens when you go to the doctors and how to keep themselves safe around medicines. They will also learn about asthma.
