Humanities:

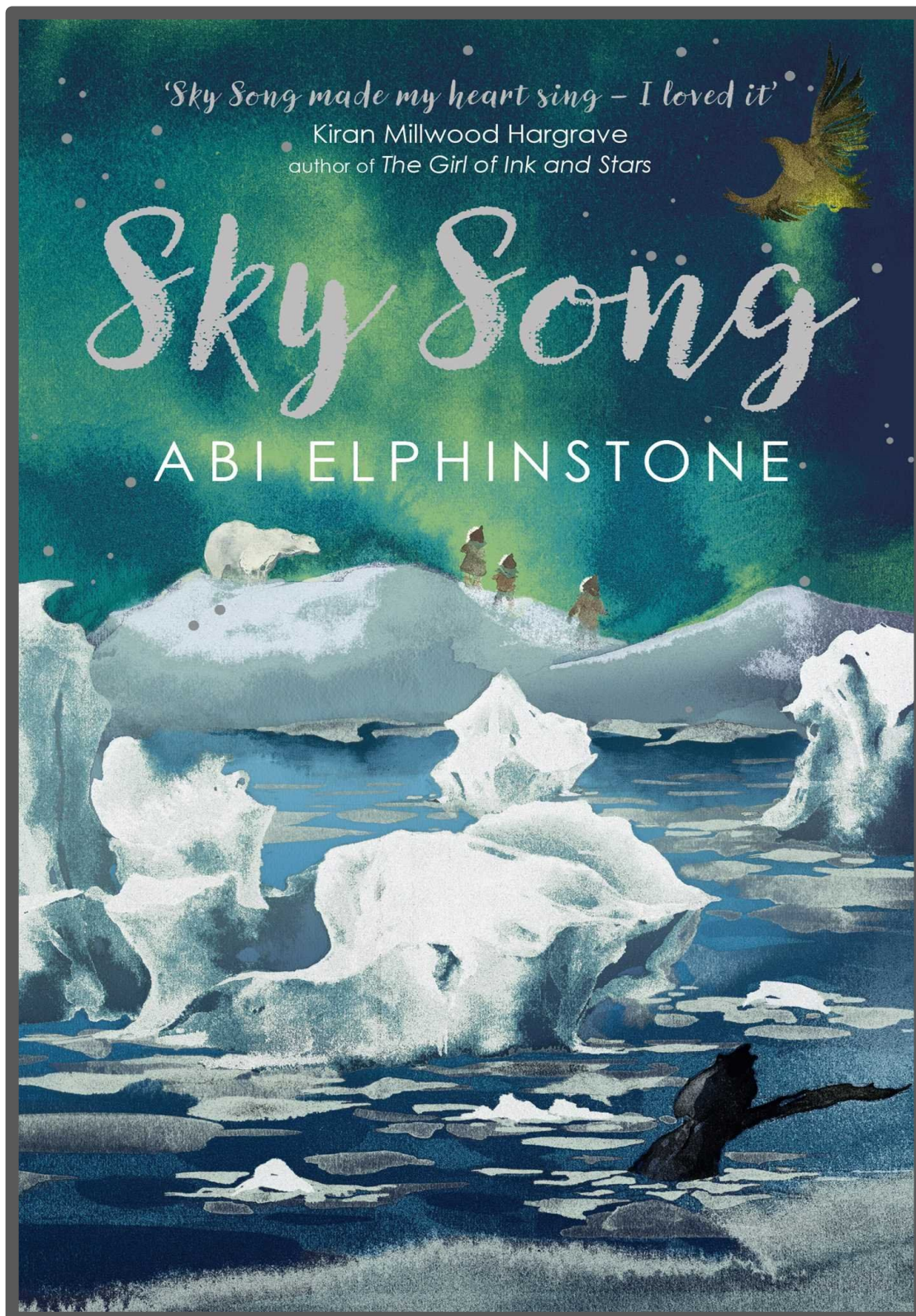
Learning about the refugee crisis and empathising with the situations in which they refugees find themselves.
