

ENGLISH

In English this half term, the children will be using the classic novel; *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* by C S



Lewis to write a portal story with a focus on setting.

They will also use the imaginary world of Narnia to help them write their own reports about magical and imaginary places.

In spellings the children will be using the spelling lists we send home weekly, please ensure they are practising them ready for their spelling tests on each Friday.

In reading, the children will use the skills of prediction and inference in their weekly guided reading sessions with their teacher. When reading at home see if they can predict what they think the outcome of a story will be.

SCIENCE

In science the children will be learning about light and shadow. As well as looking at different types of rocks what their uses are and how fossils are formed.

Computing

The children will be learning about graphs and inputting data. Children will learn to—
Set up a graph with various fields, produce graphs and share graphs made on a computer.

MATHS

In the year 3 Maths lessons their will be a big focus on telling the time.



They will learn about months and years, telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes and measuring time in seconds.

Later in the half term children will be focusing on shape. Looking at the following-

- Recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes.
- Drawing shapes accurately.
- Making 3D shapes.
- Finding angles including right, obtuse and acute.

Topic

In History the children will be learning about the times of ancient Egypt. They will learn about the role of the River Nile, ancient tombs, Tutankhamen and the gruesome process of mummification.



Art / DT

In Art and DT we will be creating our own board games. Deciding on rules of the game and how it will be played.

As well as designing the games board itself, evaluating their design and creating the board game to play.

PSHE/RE

In RE the children will be answering the Question: What does it mean to be a Jew?

In PSHE the children will learn about making healthy food choices, why it is important to make the right choice. They will also look why this can sometimes be difficult.
