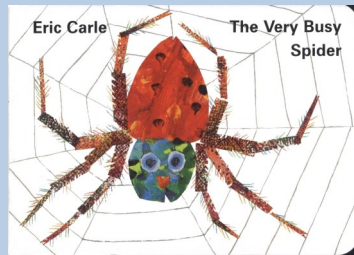


Literacy

In PE we will take part in some team games.

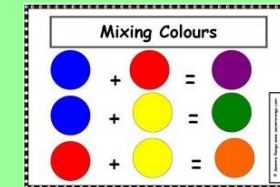


Expressive Arts and Design
