



Overview




Dear Parents and Carers,

We can't believe that we are in our final term and it only seems like yesterday that the children were coming for their first visits.

The learning that will take place this term will be the topics of '**Dinosaurs**' and '**Space**.' All teaching will be based on the topic. This covers all the early years' curriculum areas.

- **Communication, language and literacy** - Listen to and read fiction and non-fiction texts; answering simple questions about what they have read. Finding out about the habitats of different creatures. Daily phonics sessions. Use phonic knowledge to write words. Writing simple sentences related to the topic. Writing stories related to the topic.
- **Mathematics** - 'Inspire Maths,' reading and writing numbers, counting, comparing and ordering numbers to 20 and beyond. Add and subtract two single digit numbers and count on or back to find an answer. Use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, time and money.
- **RE** - Special times and special places
- **PSED** - Behaviour and changes - in preparation for transition to Year 1.
- **Understanding the world**—looking at similarities and differences. Making observations of animals,



talk about changes.


- **Music**— We will be learning space songs and Disney classics, as well as enjoying summer hymns.
- **Physical Development** - outdoor play, show control and co-ordination in large and small movements, agility, balance and large apparatus. Games - practising for sports day.
- **Expressive arts and design** - role-play, use a range of materials and techniques to create or represent ideas.


Notes and Reminders
