What to Expect on the Day

Information Workshops

Information workshops will run through the day which you can choose to attend if you wish. Workshops will explore the following themes:

- **Sleep and Contenance:** Understanding the difficulties in learning toileting skills, become more confident in recognising difficulties in children with sensory issues, where and how to get support, resources available. How and why we fall to sleep. Sleep as a behaviour, considerations for good sleep hygiene, sleep routines, practicalities of good sleep hygiene.
- **Challenging Behaviour:** The workshop will explore different ways to promote and support positive behaviour. The workshop will look at different strategies, techniques and resources that can be used to support promoting positive behaviour in Early Years.
- **My Journey as a Parent Carer:** A dad of a young child with special needs shares his experiences as a parent finding his way through the special needs system, as his child moved from early years and into school. 'What I learned along the way, what I wish I had known then'.
