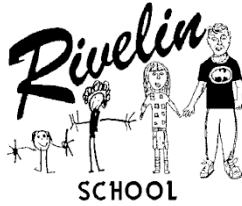

### **KS2 2019 Sports Day – Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June**

**Venue: English Institute of Sport (EIS), Coleridge Road, Sheffield S9 5DA**

We are really excited to be holding this year's KS2 Sports Day at EIS. The children and teachers will travel by coach leaving at 9.00am with a view to be seated and ready to start the sports day at 10.00am. The plan for the day is that on arrival children will take their positions down on the track with their teams. They will participate in a carousel of activities around the track and at some point during the day they will compete against each other in a variety of races.

At the end of each activity their team will be awarded with points. These points will be added together and the winning group will be presented with certificates. Parents and carers are very welcome to join us in the seated spectators' area. We aim to finish by 2.00pm and return back to school for the end of the day - 3.10pm. Please note in the interests of safety parents/carers are NOT permitted on the track.

### **Directions**

**By Car from Sheffield City Centre:** Travel through the Wicker and along Attercliffe Common towards Meadowhall. The EIS is approximately 2 miles from the city centre on the right.

### **By Public Transport**

**Bus:** A large number of bus routes serve the EIS from the Sheffield Passenger Interchange. Route numbers include: 2, 69, 130 & 287.

**Super-tram:** The Arena stop is within 100 metres of the EIS.

**Car Parking:** The EIS's on site VIP car park is normally available to users of the venue.

**Kit:** The children will be organised into groups before the event, they will represent a country and have a particular colour top to wear, for example France (Blue t-shirt), Italy (Green t-shirt), Spain (yellow t-shirt) and England (white t-shirt) If the children haven't got the appropriate colour t-shirt don't worry they could just wear their normal PE t-shirt. The children are advised to come to school ready to compete, i.e. wearing shorts, etc., under other suitable clothing, e.g. sweatshirt/tracksuit.

**Valuables** Children are advised not to bring valuable items to the EIS, as school and the venue cannot accept responsibility for any losses.

**Lunch** Children will need to bring a packed lunch. For those who are entitled and have requested them, free school meals will be in the form of a packed lunch and can be collected from the class teacher in the morning.
