<b>Phase 1</b>	Recount of the holidays. Reading and following instructions. Label parts of a plant  Phase 5 phonics	Division by separating into equal groups and by 'sharing between'.

<b>Phase 4</b>	The Tiny Seed - sequencing. Link to science - seeds - plants spread their seeds in different ways - information page  Phase 5 phonics	Understanding numbers up to 100 - in words, numerals, comparisons and represented in different forms and with different objects. Reading time to the hour and half hour.

<b>Phase 6</b>	Link to science - eating different parts of plants  Phase 5 phonics

## **Foundation Subjects**

**Science:** Much of the science will be taught through our English this half term. We also be learning:

-to identify and name a variety of common plants and trees, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

-to identify and describe the basic structure of plants and trees.

**Computing:** In computing, we will be using PowerPoint to edit text then copying and pasting images from the Internet to add to it.

**RE:** In RE this half term we will be looking at special things in nature. We will be learning about the importance and beauty of the natural world and how we need to look after it. we will also be looking at the Hindu creation stories and views on nature.

**PE:** This half term we will be learning some team games, practising races in preparation for Sports Day. We will also be doing football skills training with Colchester United.

**Art:** In Art we will be doing some reflection paintings and some wax wash observational drawings of plants, as well as recreating Monet's Irises.

**Music:** Our unit is called 'Your Imagination' and involves listening to, singing along and playing instruments for, songs related to that theme.

**PSHE:** This half term is called "keeping Safe" and we will be looking at keeping safe in the house, out and about and the people who can help us.
