Mon 17th June to Fri 21st June - SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR

The 'Scholastic' book fair will be in the school hall at 3.30pm all week - an opportunity to purchase new, exciting and educational books for your child. **In support of our reading library bus Scholastic have offered us 100% commission so the more we raise from the fair the more new books we can purchase for our new library!!!** Children who are unable to attend the fair after school can bring in money in a named envelope and can make a purchase during the day with a member of staff.

Mon 17th June -FANCY DRESS & TEACHER READING SWAP

Book Week Launch Assembly in the morning with children to come to school dressed as a book character/book themed for a fancy dress parade to start our week with a BANG!. There will be two prizes for best costume from each class.

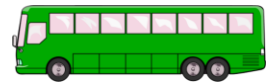
In the afternoon teachers will swap classes and read their favourite childhood book to the children.

A visit from the author **Carly Hart** who will be working in classes doing workshops. In the afternoon she will be opening our **Reading Library Bus** and hosting some reading session in there with our Library Bus Conductors. Carly will also remain in the hall at 3.30pm where you will be able to purchase some of her books and get them signed by the author herself!

Thurs 20th June - READING LIBRARY BUS VISIT & FAMILY BOOK CAFE

Classes will be given a slot during the day where they can visit the bus and spend some time browsing the books and relaxing with a good read! Our library bus conductors will be doing 'story sessions' with younger groups.

Families are invited in to school from **2pm** onwards for an afternoon of book swapping and sharing. Just bring in any books you or your child have read that you are happy to swap with someone else. Refreshments and seating will be available for relaxed reading and book discussions. Any remaining books will be placed in our new outdoor 'little free library shed' located on the post of our playground shelter. It will be open before and after school each day for any of our families to swap/exchange books throughout the year.

A visit from the author **Damian Harvey** who will be working on writing workshops across the classes. He will be in the hall at 3.30pm where you will be able to purchase some of his books and get them signed.
