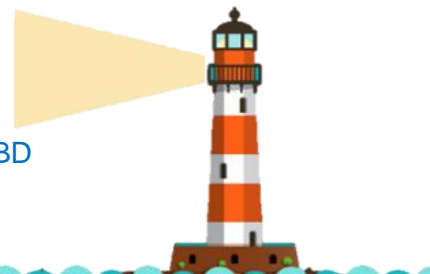

Universal Free School Meals

All children currently in Year 2 and moving to Year 3 in September 2019 must make an application for Free School Meals. That is, if parents/carers believe they are entitled to FSM, an application must be made in order for children to receive the meals.

Please remember that there is NO Universal Free School Meals and therefore NO automatic entitlement from Year 3. Only claimants that meet the FSM qualifying criteria will be entitled. And only those who make the application will be on FSM.

To avoid last minute rush and to prevent children missing out on meals or a build-up of debt, please apply by the middle of June 2019.
