

English:

Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar (SPaG): Capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, question and exclamation marks. Learning, practicing and applying letters & sounds, including alternative spellings. Suffixes– er and est. Plurals-s and es.

Information Texts (Animals), Recounts & Letters

We will be learning how to write a write an information text about an animal of our choice using headings and sub-headings. We will write a recount of our trip to 4 Kingdoms and a letter of thanks to send to the staff there.

Maths: Children will: count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number, count, read and write numbers to 100 in numeral, identify one more and one less identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. Describe measure, record and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume. Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays. **Recognise**, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
