

Literacy

The children will continue with phase 3 and 5 phonics this term. Through daily lessons, children will apply their developing phonics knowledge to their reading and writing. We will continue to practice segmenting and blending sounds in simple words and sentences. We will read a range of stories starting with 'A ticket around the world'. We will share the stories together and continue to share our views and opinions in discussions. We will continue to practice our letter formation, using capital letters and full stops in our writing and begin to use conjunctions such as 'and'.


Communication and Language

They will continue to listen to stories and will be able to recall and anticipate key events. They will share their thoughts and ideas using how and why questions. They use past, present and future forms accurately when talking.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them. Through the use of different methods children will express their thoughts, feelings and ideas. Children develop their own ideas through selecting and using materials and working on projects that interest them.

Physical Development

Children will develop the skills to move in a range of ways negotiating space as they do so. In PE we will be focusing on moving to music in a variety of ways through dance. They handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing. We will have a sports day at the end of term where we will compete in individual and team games.

Maths

We will continue to count to 20 and beyond, focusing particularly on problem solving. We will solve problems including adding and subtracting single digit numbers. We will focus on using mathematical language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects.

Personal and Social Development

Children will be confident to try new activities, and say why they like some activities more than others. They will share ideas with a familiar group.

The World

Children show an interest in the different ways of life. Through the topic around the world children will look at similarities and differences between cultures. We will look at the differences between the homes, food, religions and clothes of different cultures. We will taste some foods from around the world. We have a trip to Peshaw monument and Herrington park to explore our local landmarks.
